

Financial help for students 2011 / 2012

The Bursary Fund

Purpose of the Fund:

- To assist students who may have difficulties in completing their course because of financial considerations.
- To assist with unforeseen emergencies where completion of the course could be jeopardised by financial constraints.
- To help students with direct costs of study such as transport, fees, books, equipment, exam costs, field trips.

To Qualify:

- As a general guide, students who have a household income of up to £18,500 per annum should apply to the Bursary Fund if they require financial assistance. You will be required to complete an application form and submit evidence of income, usually your Tax Credit Award Notice. If your application is successful you will receive your award for specific costs, for example travel expenses, and will be paid on receipt of proof of purchase.
- If you are worried about any financial aspect of your course, you should apply.
- **The Guaranteed Bursary:** Students in care, care leavers, young people in receipt of income support and disabled young people in receipt of Employment Support Allowance who are also in receipt of Disability Living Allowance will be eligible to receive a bursary of £1,200 a year.
