Awards and Specifications:

As part of your course on Website Development you will use HTML, CSS and JavaScript. We need you to complete the following course:

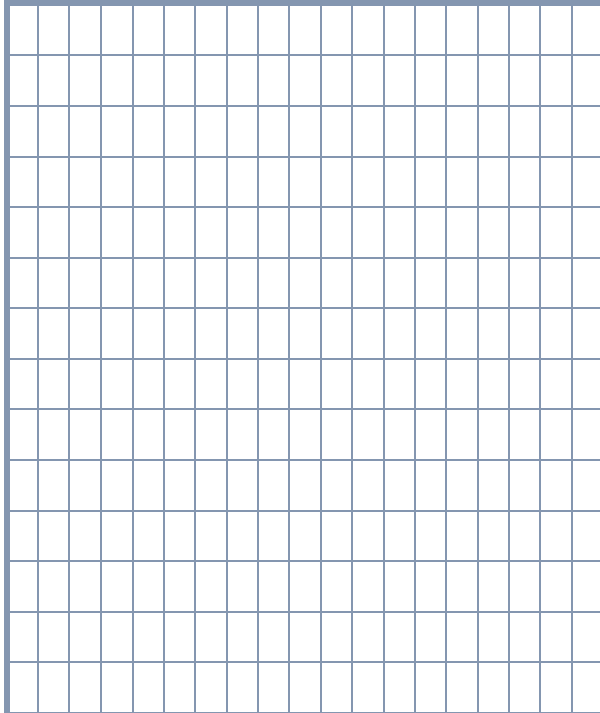

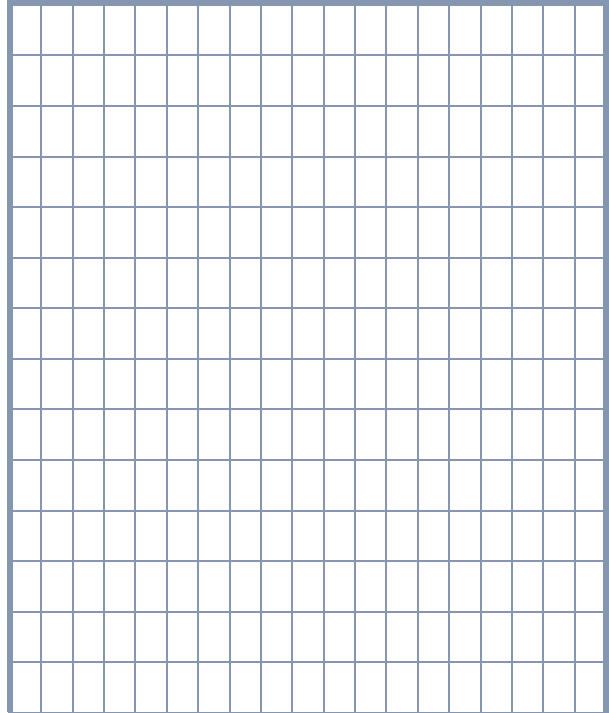
